This guide provides the information you need to install InteleViewer<sup>TM</sup> on an Apple<sup>®</sup> Mac OS  $X^{\mathbb{R}}$  operating system.

### About InteleViewer on a Mac

You can run InteleViewer sessions on the Mac OS X operating system provided you have the necessary user privilege and system requirements.

### **User and Site Privileges**

You must have the Mac Client user privilege enabled to open an InteleViewer session on a Mac.

The site you want to access must also be configured to allow users with the Mac Client user privilege to run InteleViewer sessions. Unless both conditions are met, you cannot log in to InteleViewer.

### System Requirements

To run InteleViewer on a Mac, the following is required:

- IntelePACS 3.7.1 R20, IntelePACS 3.8.1 R14, IntelePACS 4.1.1 R7, or IntelePACS 4.2.1 or later
- Mac OS  $X^{\mathbb{R}}$  Snow Leopard<sup>TM</sup> or OS  $X^{\mathbb{R}}$  Mountain Lion with 64-bit processor
- Java<sup>®</sup> 1.6 64-bi

### Installing InteleViewer on a Mac

You can run InteleViewer on a Mac.

### To install InteleViewer on a Mac:

- **1.** Log in to InteleBrowser.
- 2. In the InteleBrowser main menu, click Installers.

The Intelerad User Resources page appears.

- **3.** Click InteleViewer Tracks. The InteleViewer Tracks page appears.
- From Evaluation Track, Advanced Track, or Stable Track, click Download InteleViewer for the Mac OS X Installer. The Opening InteleViewer.dmg dialog appears.
- **5.** Enable the Save File option and click OK. The Downloads dialog appears.
- Double-click *InteleViewer.dmg*.
  This disk image contains the InteleViewer application and a license agreement.

- **7.** Drag the InteleViewer application to the Applications folder at the top level of the hard disk on your Mac.
- 8. Double-click InteleViewer.
- 9. To provide quick access to InteleViewer, add it to the Dock.

### Changes to InteleViewer Shortcut Keys on a Mac

On a Mac keyboard, the shortcut keys for performing the actions below are different than those on a Windows<sup>®</sup> PC keyboard:

- To access Help documentation, press FN+F1.
- To reset an image, press CTRL+DELETE.
- To delete a selected measurement, press FN+DELETE.

### **InteleViewer Feature Limitations on a Mac**

When running InteleViewer on a Mac, the following features are disabled or unavailable:

- Viewing the worklist.
- Exporting to DICOM by using InteleViewer.
- Burning to CD-ROM.
- Integrations with third-party applications running on Windows<sup>®</sup>.
- Philips<sup>®</sup> SpeechMike<sup>™</sup> integration.
- Launching InteleViewer from InteleBrowser.
- Advanced Visualization, except Orthogonal MPR (which is available).

**Note:** Your user account must be assigned the Image Reformat Functionality privilege to use the Orthogonal MPR tool on a Mac.

- Upgrading by using the Utilities | Check for Application Update command.
- Terminal services.
- DICOM services, including autorouting, retrieval, working offline, sending to PACS.
- Multi-Method Reporting.
- · Exporting images to video.
